



COVID-19 Policy

All members to comply with the UK Government and Angling Trust guidelines in respect of the latest COVID-19 advice laid out in the [Angling Trust's Covid-19 Guidelines](#).

PSAC guidance on fishing from March 29th:

These are the Angling Trust's views on the guidance and restrictions effective Monday 29th March 2021 (27th March for Wales)

You should not travel from England to Wales or travel from Wales to England to fish.

- In England fishing is permitted for up to 6 people, or a larger group if everyone is from the same two households/support bubbles.
- In Wales fishing is permitted for up to 4 people from 2 households/support bubble.
- Night fishing can recommence.
- Travel to fish is now allowed but excessive travel should be avoided.

Matches will recommence in line with relevant Covid-19 guidance on Saturday 3rd April 2021.

Self-Isolation following a positive Covid test still applies.

Remember Covid-19 has not gone away!!

Be very mindful of the advice to maintain distance from others specially in car parks, wear a mask when necessary and clean or gel your hands regularly particularly when handling locks and opening and closing gates.



Members should respect Government travel guidance. Traveling to fish is allowed but excessive travel should be avoided.

Anglers shall maintain a minimum of 2 metres space between those who are not part of the same household and other anglers whilst fishing.

Where anglers arrive at a pool and are unable to find a swim which meets the 2-metre spacing requirement on their chosen pool they must leave that pool immediately for another pool.

No Peg sharing except with members of the same household.

When a Bailiff or Committee Member asks to inspect your membership card, the card is best passed over in a landing net to maintain social distancing.



Members to carry appropriate hand sanitisers with them for frequent cleaning of hands especially after handling gates and locks.

Work parties reduced with volunteers for the remaining work parties restricted to comply with Government Guidelines and to ensure social distancing.
